D. **B.A/B.Com(Honours) Semester system** -Examination rules, Admission rules and Promotion rules in the next Semester/to award Degree.

6 th	(i)Must be a regular students and have 75 % attendance. (ii) Should not have <u>more than 4 back papers in the 3rd ,4th& 5th Sem. taken together</u>	1.Students who passed all the Semester examination in regular attempt and secured at least 85% marks in aggregate of all Honours subject (includes marks in elective paper of Honours subject)will be placed in the Class “ Honours with Distinction ” 2.Students who secured 60% or above marks,but below 85% in aggregate of all Honours subject (includes marks in elective paper of Honours subject) will be placed in the First Class . 3. Students who secured 45% or above marks,but below 60% in aggregate of all Honours subject (includes marks in elective paper of Honours subject) will be placed in the Second Class . 4. Students who passes all the papers but secures less than 45% marks will be placed in the “ Pass only ”Class.

Notes:

1. Students who could not pass/could not be promoted to the next higher semester may be permitted to appear at the **next examination of the same semester as casual candidate** by filling examination form & paying the prescribed fee.
2. Not withstanding anything contained in the above clauses, a students must complete the Course **within a continuous span of Ten Semester** from his/her initial admission.
